VIRTUAL WATERCOLOR WORKSHOP *with ALAN JAMES*



Alan James is an award-winning watercolor artist and teacher. His art appears in collections worldwide and he has studied with some of the great watercolor masters such as Alvaro Castagnet, Joseph Zbukvic, and Herman Pikel.



Alan's style is impressionistic and traditionalist with emphasis on purity of design and clear, transparent colors. His art captures the very soul of his subjects with passion, boldness and elegance. His paintings are imbued with a mood - a mystery that engages and lures the viewer into the magic.

Alan's work is represented at galleries in Nantucket, MA (Nantucket Artworks, Trinity Collection), Virginia Beach, VA (Richard Stravitz Fine Art, and Deep River, CT (Alan Hames Gallery). Many examples of his work can be seen at <http://www.alanjamesart.com/>.

In this workshop you will follow along with Alan as he instructs participants using his fluid three-step approach. His live, interactive Zoom presentation will allow you to observe, then paint each step and ask questions along the way. Be sure to watch his demonstration at the online September 16th MAA meeting to get an idea of the process. A general palette, good quality watercolor paper, and a small selection of brushes are all you need. See the attached supply list for details.



SUPPLY LIST

- Palette
- General color assortment of pigments (specific colors not important)
- Good Watercolor paper (pad or ¼ sheet Arches, Kilimanjaro, Fabriano, etc.)
- Backing board to tape paper to if not using pad
- Brushes (large mop brush, synthetic round brushes in large, medium, and small sizes)
- Pencil and soft/kneaded eraser
- Paper towels or tissues (whatever you use to control water)
- Water spray bottle
- Water container
